


Dovedale Primary School



What's happening this half term

Maths— We will continue this half term with our unit of work on money. Children will learn to make amounts, calculate with money, solve problems and calculate change. We will then move on to multiplication and division using practical equipment, visual images and written methods.

Reading—We will continue to focus on reading comprehension this half term with pupils completing regular written comprehension exercises. These will help children develop their skills of retrieval, inference, prediction, sequencing and understanding of vocabulary.

Writing—Our writing lessons will closely link with our geography topic this half term and with texts based around the theme of Africa. Children will write stories, non-chronological reports, poems and letters.

Science—Our science topic this half term is Animals including humans. We will find out about the basic needs of animals and humans for survival and understand the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of foods and hygiene.

Geography— Our geography topic is Africa. Children will use maps and atlases to explore the continent of Africa and will complete their own maps showing different landscapes, rivers, mountains and countries. They will compare life in an African village to African city life and consider how their own life differs to that of an African school child.

Art—In art we will study African art including the use of pattern and colour. We will design, make and decorate our own African clay pot.

Other—All children will experience a part of African culture by taking part in an African drumming and dance workshop. They will have the opportunity to play a range of African drums, learn traditional African dance and perform alongside their classmates.



PE/Clothing

Children do PE on alternate Monday and Wednesday afternoons this half term. Please ensure PE kits are in school.

Spellings will continue to be sent home on a Monday and tested on a Friday and will link to spelling rules covered in school.
