



The Ways to Work Programme

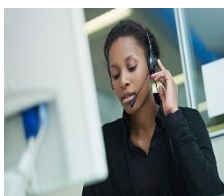


Ways to Work is open to those who are you 18+ and not already in employment; training or education.

There is no upper age limit. It is a free service, funded by the European Social Fund, to help people start work, find a course; training or an apprenticeship. There is additional help available for 18-24 year olds, via the Kickstart Programme.

Just contact us to arrange an appointment, to discuss how we can support you to:

- Register with the Ways to Work Programme.
- Design a personal plan, to address any issues you might face in trying to find suitable work.
- Plan any training you might need.
- Create a C.V
- Discover the different job/training opportunities available now.
- Apply for jobs/training.
- Prepare for an interview
- Find affordable childcare, if needed.
